Thank you to everyone who has shown interest in providing bids for the fencing projects recently posted by AACD. We understand there are some questions about the bid specifications, and we hope to answer them here.

- <u>Regarding stated project miles</u>: The miles provided on the project maps are **USDA mapped miles**. These miles reflect a project's defined parameters from point A to point B and are what must be completed.
- <u>Regarding bid totals</u>: Bid totals must reflect the total amount of labor to complete the project within the defined parameters (USDA mapped miles, point A to point B).
- <u>Fencing materials</u>: Materials provided will be for the miles defined on the project map.
- <u>Regarding Wilderness</u>: Projects that include Wilderness Boundary fence require no additional specifications for fence building. Packing supplies to site is required and no machinery is allowed for cutting or brushing.

Once again, we **strongly** encourage bidders to physically walk the projects they are interested in bidding. If, after your on-the-ground assessment of the project site, you feel that additional labor and materials will be needed to complete the project, we ask that you include this in your total bid proposal along with a justification statement.
