Triangle & Chino Winds NRCD Project Presentation given by Dawn Salcito. A power point presentation was given to describe the statues, responsibilities and projects.

Future projects within Triangle & Chino Winds NRCD Boundaries presented by Deborah Smith AACD Executive Director.

John Rose Prescott National Forest (PNF) Archaeologist talked about the MOU with AACD. The Archaeologist hired by Triangle & Chino Winds NRCD has completed multiple cultural surveys for PNF. This success caused PNF to find funding opportunities that an MOU/MOA could manage.

Questions from the audience:

Matt Bates asked John Rose if surveys were required for dirt tank cleaning or if there was flexibility? Rose stated that if the cleaning stays within the boundaries no survey was required. Rose also explained they will revisit a sample of tanks to see if they stayed within boundaries. He encouraged producers to contact heritage, including their range cons, for future questions/concerns.

Anne Verner also wanted Rose to be aware of a cultural survey needed to replace an existing H Brace. The burden of surveys on existing structures causes frustration and potential issues with pasture moves. Rose thought that the H Brace fell under the definition of Screened Exemptions. Rose encouraged Verner to contact her range con and him for a site specific conversation.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Gail Steiger and seconded by Matt Bates to adjourn the meeting.
